




### eu-LISA Key Facts


- Start of operation: 01/12/2012

# Existing systems for asylum and migration management operated by eu-LISA at central level





## **CU-LISA** Eurodac


#### Eurodac data transmitted: 2014-2020

#### Eurodac

- Used by asylum and migration authorities for the Dublin Regulation
- Contains fingerprints but no alphanumerical data

#### eu-LISA:

- Responsible for ensuring uninterrupted access to the system 24/7
- Eurodac Advisory Group
- Eurodac annual technical report
- Eurodac annual statistics
- List of designated authorities accessing Eurodac




- Record traffic in 2015-2016
- In 2020, the traffic decreased 30% compared to 2019
- Since 2018, the overall traffic has been below one million, similar to prior the period prior 2015

### Eurodac legislative proposal (COM 2016 and 2020)

**COM proposal for new Eurodac** aims at transforming Eurodac into a common European database to support EU policies on asylum, resettlement and irregular migration.

- What is missing is a database for irregular/illegal migration identifying those who are apprehended entering irregularly or staying illegally in the Schengen area
- Today the **collection and limited storing** of fingerprints serves strictly the purpose of facilitating the application of the Dublin Regulation
- Thousands of migrants remain invisible in Europe, including unaccompanied minors.

### The Eurodac legislative proposal (COM 2016 and 2020)




#### Visa applications stored in VIS: 2016-2020

VIS

- Management of visa applications, identification and verification of thirdcountry nationals travelling to the Schengen Area
- Used by consular posts, border, asylum and law enforcement authorities (conditions apply)
- Facial images and fingerprints

eu-LISA

- Responsible for ensuring 24/7 access to the system
- VIS Advisory Group
- VIS biannual technical report with statistics
- List of designated authorities accessing VIS



- The number of visa applications increased considerably between 2016-2019
- In 2020 it witnessed a decrease for the first time
- <u>Yearly</u> processed visa applications were 15-17 mln in 2016-2019, those dropped to 3 mln in 2020

#### **Revised VIS - Regulation (EU) 2021/1134**

In preparation phase by COM, MS and eu-LISA.



- In addition to short-stay visas it will also cover long-stay visas and residence permits, closing an information gap for border and law enforcement authorities
- All visa applications recorded in VIS will be automatically checked against all other EU information systems for security and migration
- Will include fingerprints and facial images
- The fingerprinting age is lowered from 12 to 6 years, 75 years as the upper age limit


#### e-Visa platform - legal proposal being developed by COM




Entry-into-operation September 2022



- EES Regulation (EU) 2017/2226
  System for border authorities
- Individual files of entry & exit records of TCN to/from Schengen area
- Will replace stamping of passports
- Will allow identification of overstayers
- Fingerprints and facial images
- Access by authorised staff of Frontex

Entry-into-operation May 2023



- ETIAS Regulation (EU) 2018/1240
- Pre-authorisation of third country nationals from visa-free countries
- Verification of security, illegal immigration or high epidemic risk
- Central System, NUI, carrier gateway, secure web service, website & mobile app
- Frontex will manage the Central Unit
- Verification against eu-LISA, Europol and Interpol databases



#### Entry-into-operation December 2023


## Interoperability components:

- European Search Portal
- Shared Biometric Matching Service
- Common Identity Repository
- Multiple Identity Detector
- Common Repository of Reporting and Statistics

#### Interoperability of existing and new systems will:

- Make existing and new systems (silo approach)
  interoperable to facilitate information sharing between
  Facilitate the processing of visa and asylum
  applications
- Improve detection of irregular migrants
- Allow detection of multiple identities
- Ensure that end-users have fast and seamless access to data stored in all the systems by eu-LISA for crosschecking (based on legal bases)

#### eu-LISA contributes to more efficient asylum and migration management through:

- ✓ existing IT systems (Eurodac and VIS + recast systems) and
- ✓ **new IT systems** (EES, ETIAS and Interoperability)



eu-LISA contributes to digitalisation of the JHA area (incl. migration & asylum) through:

- ✓ Working towards application of **new technologies** in our systems
- ✓ **Designing new tools**, e.g. digital visa platform
- ✓ Implementing AI components in the systems in the future
- ✓ Taking steps towards further **standardisation and automation** to support MS



**Need to improve cooperation with third countries**, especially neighbouring countries, to ensure compatibility between their systems and ours to enable exchange of information in the future. eu-LISA is involved in relevant projects with Western Balkan countries.
